Candidates must send your complete documentation to ACCPO. (accpo2021.23@gmail.com) once the documents are received, they will review, and the final decision will be made by the Foundation.

Candidates Requirements:

1. Completed bio sketch (with photo)
 2. Fluency in Spanish and English
 3. Completed Ophthalmology Residency (certificate required)
 4. Completed their national ophthalmological association appointment (certificate required)
 5. Letter of recommendation from the candidates Chair/Chief of Service including a commitment to take the fellow back to practice ophthalmic oncology in their country
 6. Preferably be under 40 years of age
 7. Will co-author in at least 1 publication (ECF Fellowship support) during fellowship
 8. Deadline to send documents is November 30th, 2021.
 9. The fellowship is scheduled to begin on February 1st, 2022.
- The Eye Cancer Foundation will issue a stipend to the candidate for \$8.000USD given upon arrived to Colombia for 6-month clinical experience resulting in an ophthalmic oncology certification from Dr. Calle and The Eye Cancer Foundation.
 - COVID-19 vaccination is required.
 - The candidate must attach a current national or international health and accident policy for the training period
 - Visa required, Drs. Calle and Finger will provide proof of invitation.
